Red River UU Policy for Certification of Petitions Adopted July 21, 2009

Content:

Petitions submitted to Red River Unitarian Universalist Church must contain the following information:

- 1. A statement of purpose must describe the concern, position, or situation, include a specific request for action, and state the reason the petition is needed.
- 2. The statement of purpose must be printed at the top of each page of the petition.
- 3. Each signatory on the petition must be a voting member in good standing at the time the petition is submitted to the Board of Trustees.
- 4. Each signature must be accompanied by the printed name of the signatory and the date signed.
- 5. The petition can only be circulated by voting members in good standing.

Petitions submitted to Red River Unitarian Universalist Church must be accompanied by a statement of certification signed by the member who circulated the petition. If multiple members circulated the petition, a separate statement of certification must be submitted by each member.
